FOR A PATIENT REGISTERED WITH A GP IN SCOTLAND

- Minor Ailments Service
- Pharmacy First
 - Treatment for uncomplicated UTI in women aged between 16 and 65
 - Treatment for impetigo in patients over 2 years old
- Emergency Hormonal Contraception
- Access to urgent supply of prescribed medicines



FOR A PATIENT REGISTERED WITH A GP IN THE REST OF THE UK

- Pharmacy First
 - Treatment for uncomplicated UTI in women aged between 16 and 65
 - Treatment for impetigo in patients over 2 years old
- Emergency Hormonal Contraception
- Access to up to 30 days emergency supply of prescribed medicines (max 5 days for phenobarbital and any Sch 4 & 5 CDs - a charge will apply



FOR A PATIENT NOT REGISTERED WITH A GP IN THE UK

- Patients from the EEA/Switzerland can obtain up to 30 days' emergency supply of medication from community pharmacy (max 5 days for Phenobarbital for epilepsy and Sch 4&5 CDs) provided the pharmacist is comfortable to do so. A charge will apply for any supply made.
- Patients from outside of the EEA/Switzerland cannot obtain emergency supplies of medication via community pharmacy.
